FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When do Palm Tran buses run?

Buses run 7 days a week, serving more than 3,200 bus stops from Jupiter to Boca Raton and west to the Glades. Generally speaking, weekday peak service runs every 30 minutes, off-peak service runs hourly, and weekend service runs hourly on most routes.

What safety features are available on Palm Tran buses?

All Palm Tran buses are equipped with voice announcements as well as audio & visual surveillance equipment to ensure passenger safety.

I am a senior citizen who is no longer able to stand at a bus stop. Is there any other transportation available for me?

Palm Tran Connection, a shared ride, door-to-door paratransit service, is available for qualifying individuals who are unable to transport themselves to health care, employment, education, shopping, social activities, or other life-sustaining activities. FAST, CONVENIENT, AND FREE YOUR KEY TO THE PALM BEACHES

As a resident of Century Village Boca Raton, you have been granted the incredible convenience of riding Palm Tran's fixed-route bus service for **FREE**. All you need to do is present your Century Village I.D. with your unique Palm Tran hologram sticker, shown below, to the bus operator when you board the bus. If you have any questions or concerns regarding your free access, please contact your Century Village clubhouse.

EXAMPLE



BEFORE YOU BOARD

1 Use the Palm Tran Rider's Guide to determine which route(s) you need to take to reach your destination. You can pick up a copy at your Century Village clubhouse.



2 Once you've determined which route to take and the schedule for your bus, find the bus stop sign at your Century Village clubhouse. The bus route number is indicated on the sign.

3 As the bus approaches, stand up or become visible so the bus operator knows you want to board. Stand away from the curb until the bus comes to a complete stop.

DURING YOUR TRIP

4 When you enter the bus, remember to watch your step! If the step is too high, ask the bus operator to lower it by having the bus "kneel". All Palm Tran buses can kneel, accommodating passengers with special needs.

5 Have a seat and enjoy the ride. Seats at the front of the bus are reserved for senior citizens or passengers using a mobility device.

6 As your stop approaches, pull down the "stop indicator" cord running along each side of the bus. This will notify the bus operator to stop at the next stop. Remember to signal your stop request at least one block in advance.

AFTER YOU ARRIVE

7 Wait until the bus comes to a complete stop before exiting through the rear doors. Remember to check for traffic after you've exited the bus. Traffic does not stop for public transit as it does for school buses.

CONGRATULATIONS!

By following these steps, you can take Palm Tran anywhere you want to go in Palm Beach County.
